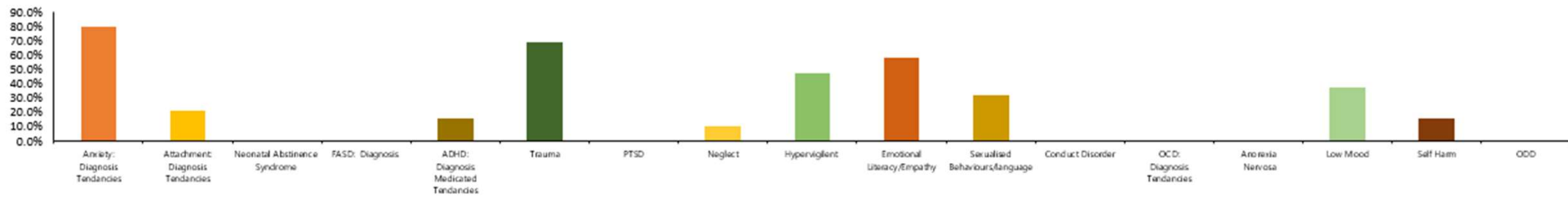

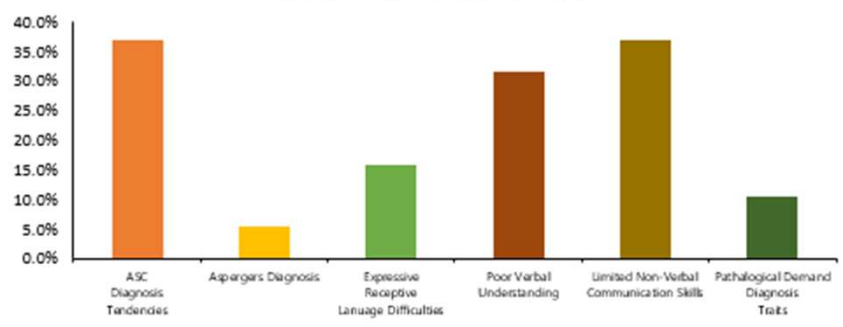

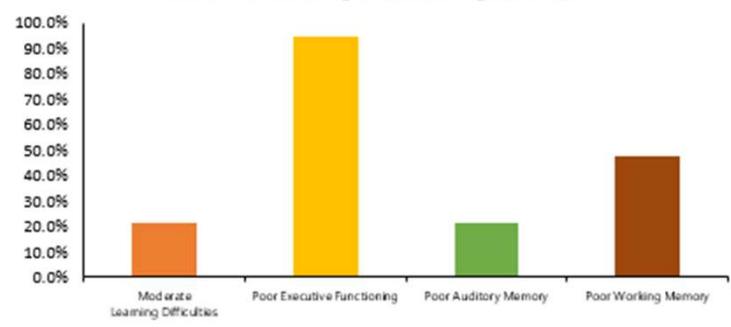

% of students with SEMH Needs



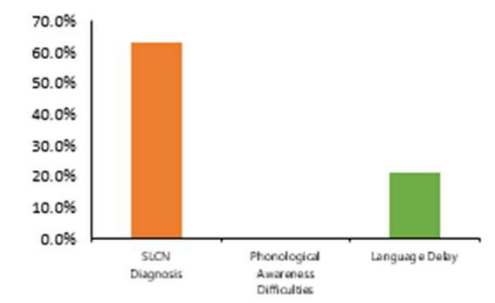
% of students with Communication Difficulties



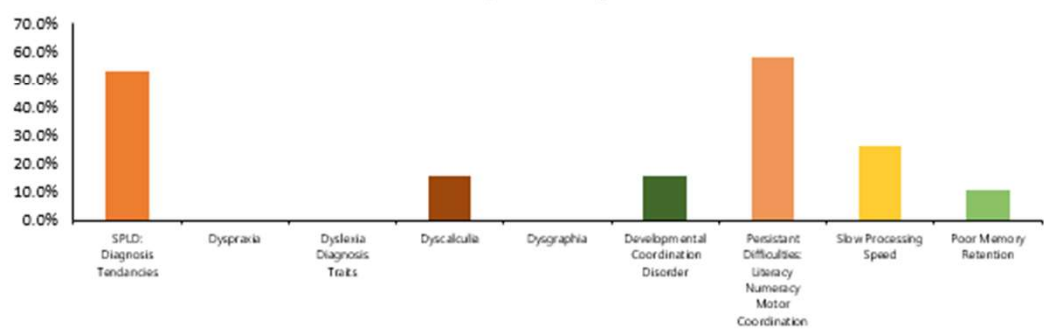
% of students with Cognition & Learning Difficulties



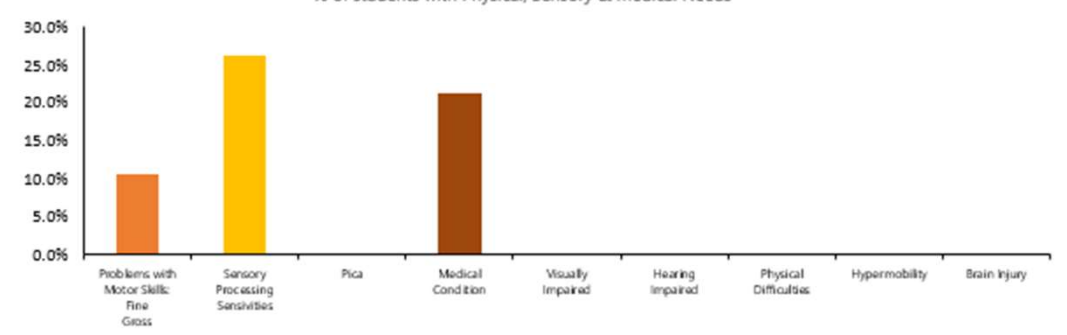
% of students with Speech, Language & Communication Needs



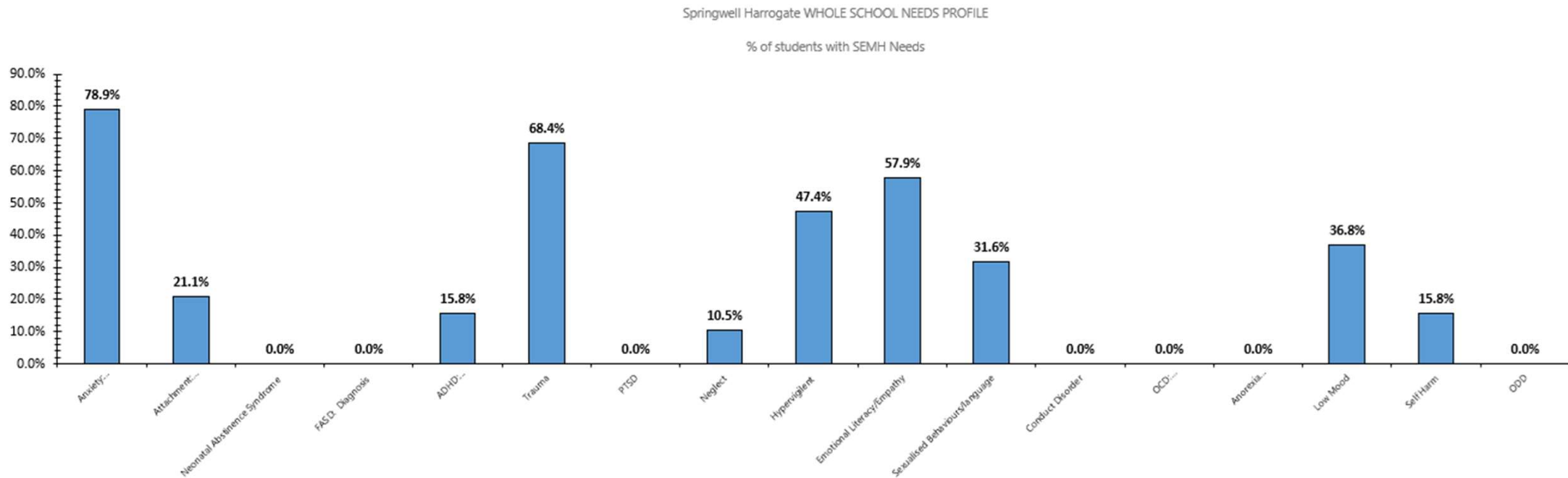
% of students with Specific Learning Difficulties

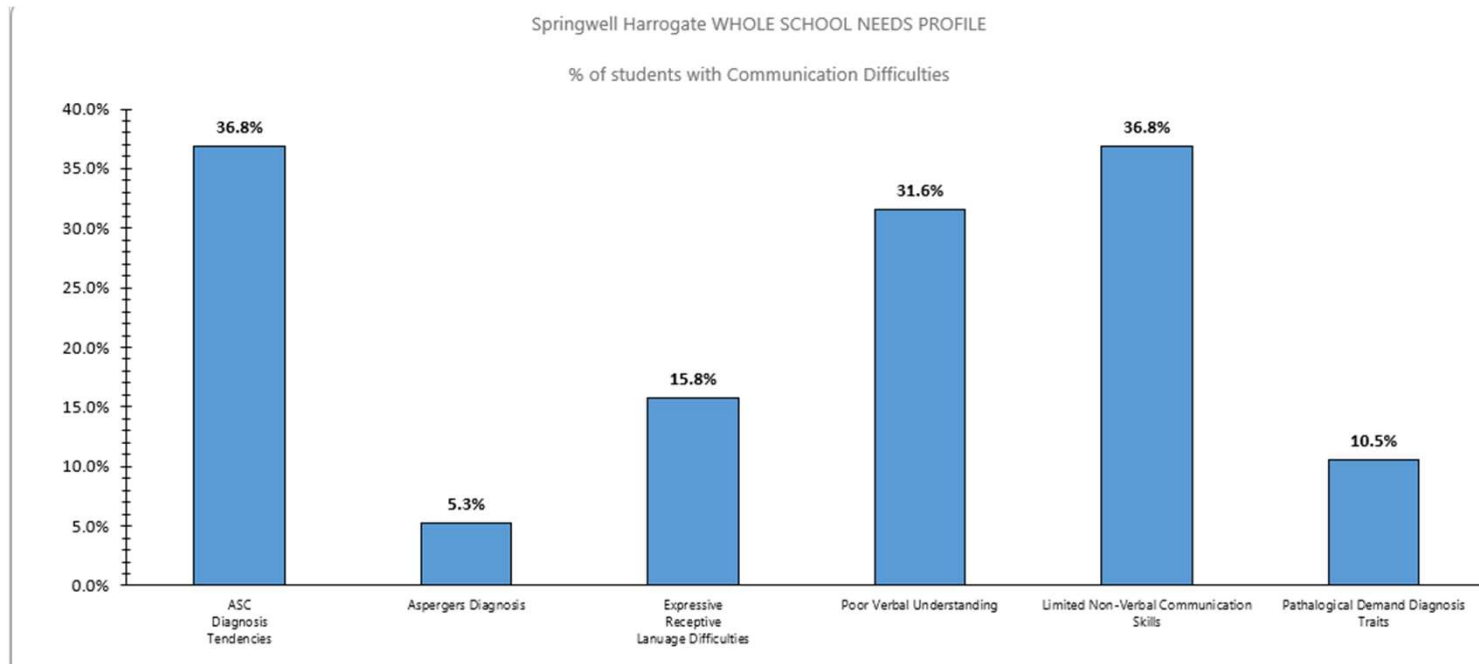

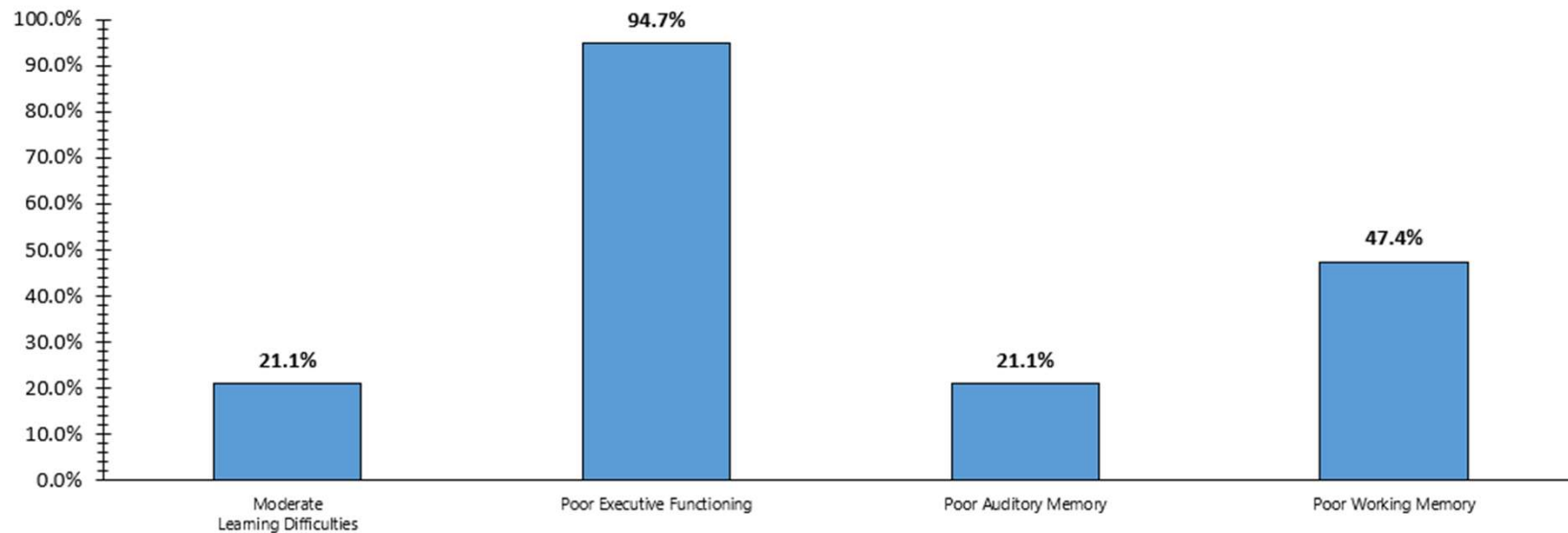

% of students with Cognition & Learning Difficulties



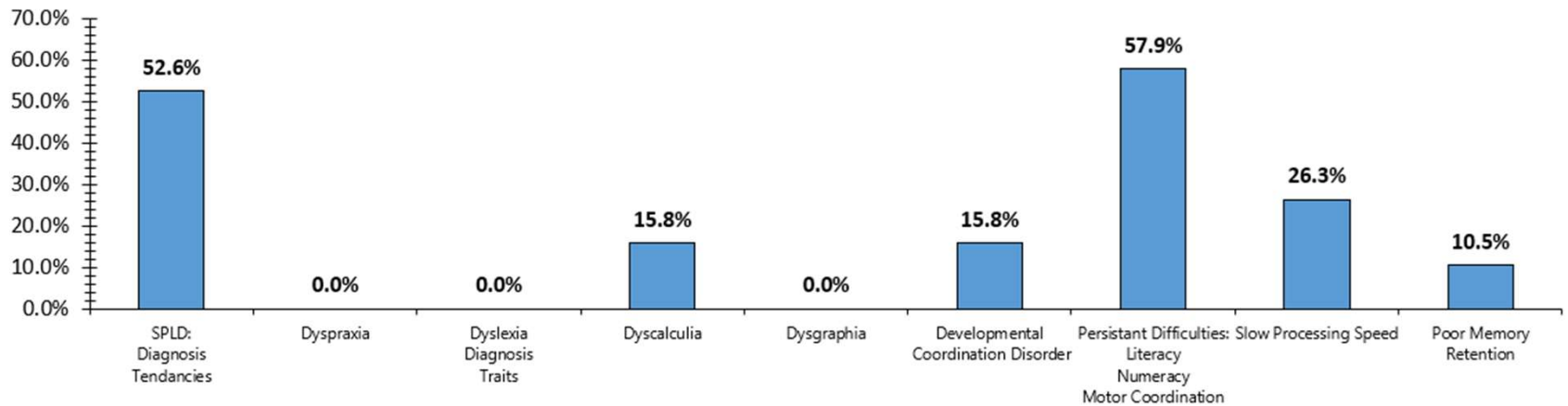

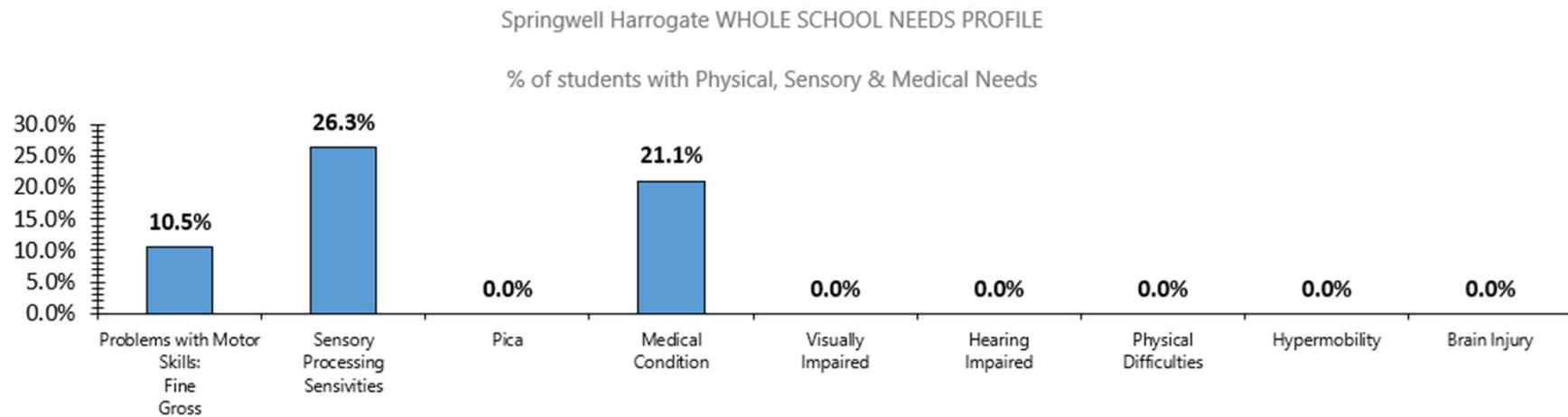

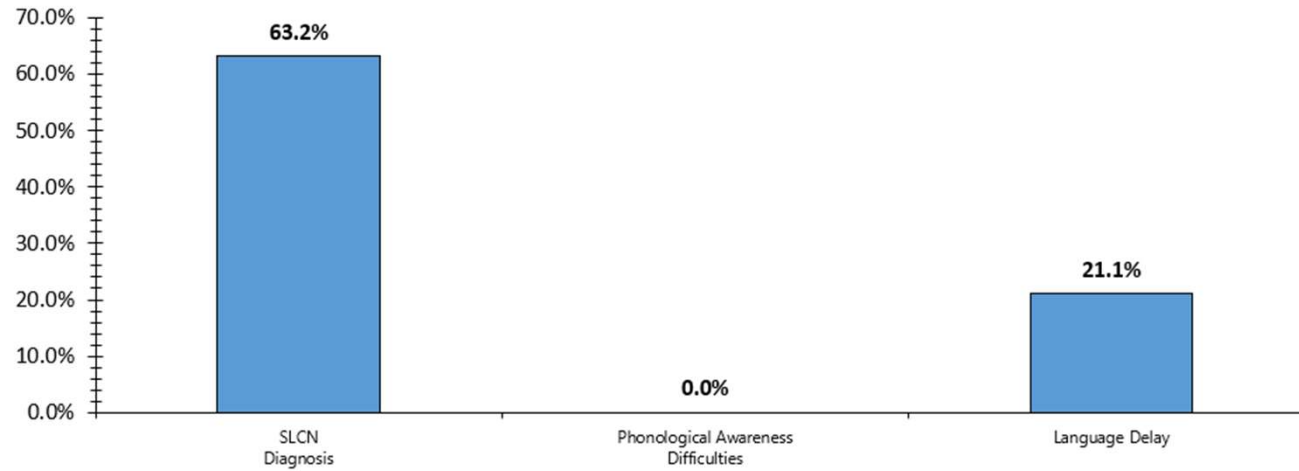
